### **Club Swift** Mondays, 2:30—3:30pm at Boys & Girls Club on Palomino Campus

Club Swift is a leadership development program geared primarily towards teens living in the same communities as our campers, but all teen volunteers are welcome to attend. This program meets weekly to develop the leadership, communication, and social skills that are important to not only be successful Swift counselors, but also to become successful leaders in the community. ### **Swift after School** Mondays, 3:45-4:30 at Palomino Intermediate School

Swift after School is a fun, safe, and free space for youth and teens to engage with one-another after the academic school day is over. Approximately 50 youth ages 8-11 participate in this program each week to play sports and participate in enrichment and team-building activities. Teens are invited to attend on a drop-in or regular basis to assist with programs and activities, all while acting as mentors for the youth participants. Swift after School is always a ton of fun, and it's a great way to develop ongoing mentor relationships with youth in need.

### **Club Swift Jr** Saturdays Monthly, 9:30am—11:00am at Boys & Girls Club on Palomino Campus

Club Swift Jr is a leadership training program for former Camp Swift campers. Participants work on interpersonal and leadership skills to prepare them to be strong counselors once they're in high school.

### **Swift Saturdays Monthly**, 11:30am—1pm at Boys & Girls Club on Palomino Campus

Swift Saturdays are another great way for teen volunteers to get involved as mentors. Once per month, youth ages 8-11 from various Title I schools come together to participate in a fun day of art, sports, and science activities. Teens are invited to attend on a drop in basis to help with the activities and to play with the kids. Everyone who attends is provided with a free lunch, and a chance to develop lasting mentor relationship with youth in need.

### **Swift Carnival** February 23rd, 11:00am—3:00pm at Palomino Intermediate School

Approximately 200 youth ages 5-7 from Title I schools around the metro Phoenix area are invited to enjoy the festivities of playing carnival games, getting their faces painted, jumping in bounce houses, and enjoying freshly prepared BBQ lunch. Teen volunteers are grouped with the campers, and they help ensure that everyone gets to enjoy all the festivities the carnival has to offer.
