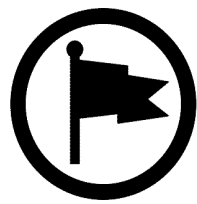

## PROGRAM INFORMATION

### **Swift After School — Thursdays, 2:45 - 4:45 PM at Palomino Intermediate School**

#### **Volunteers please arrive at 2:30 PM**

Swift After School is a fun, safe, and free space for youth and teens to engage with one another after the academic school day is over. Approximately 50 youth ages 8-12 participate in the program each week to play sports and participate in enrichment and team-building activities. Teen mentors are invited to attend on a drop-in or regular basis to assist with programs and activities, all while acting as mentors for the youth participants. Swift After School is always a ton of fun, and it's a great way to develop ongoing mentor relationships with youth in need.

### **Club Swift Jr. — Saturdays Monthly, 10:00 AM - 1:00 PM at Boys & Girls Club on Palomino Campus**

Club Swift Jr. is a leadership training program designed to foster the positive development of middle school youth who are former Camp Swift campers and Swift After School participants. The overarching goal of the program is to continue supporting the social and emotional development of youth participants in Swift programs as they age into middle school and transition to high school. Participants work on interpersonal and leadership skills to prepare them to be strong counselors once they're in high school.

### **Swift Saturdays — Saturdays Monthly, 11:00 AM - 1:00 PM at Boys & Girls Club on Palomino Campus**

Swift Saturdays are another great way for teen mentors to continue volunteering year-round. Once per month, youth ages 8 - 12 from various Title 1 schools come together to participate in a fun day of art, sports, and science activities. Teen mentors are invited to volunteer on a drop-in basis to help with activities and engage with the youth participants. Everyone who attends is provided with a free lunch, and a chance to further develop lasting mentor relationships with youth in need.

### **Swift Carnival — February 22nd, 12:00 AM - 2:00 PM at Palomino Intermediate Campus**

Seventh through twelfth grade teens team up with kindergarten through sixth grade students from Title 1 Schools and are invited to play carnival games, have their faces painted, and visit engaging attractions. Teen volunteers are grouped with youth participants and they help ensure that everyone gets to enjoy all the festivities the carnival has to offer.
